The Sunnybrook REB has adopted the N2/CAREB REB SOPs and in order to reflect specific Sunnybrook REB requirements, this addendum complements the N2/CAREB REB SOP noted below.

N2/CAREB REB SOP: # 201 – Composition of the REB

N2/CAREB REB SOP	Sunnybrook REB SOP Addendum
 5.2.3 The REB will include at least five members represented by the following categories: At least two members who have expertise in relevant research disciplines, field and methodologies covered by the REB (for biomedical clinical trials, this will include at least one member who practises medicine or dentistry and who is in good standing with their regulatory body), At least one member who is primarily experienced in non-scientific disciplines At least one member who is knowledgeable in ethics, At least one member who is knowledgeable in the relevant law. This is mandatory for biomedical research and is advisable, but not mandatory, for other areas of research, and At least one community member who has no affiliation with the organization or the sponsor, and who is not part of the immediate family of a person who is affiliated with the organization; 	 In addition to the existing membership requirements listed in 5.2.3, the REB will also include at least one member knowledgeable in privacy issues, as per the Ontario Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA) 2004.
