GETTING STARTED

STEP 1: REFERRAL

Ask your physician to send a referral to St. John's Rehab Outpatient Services.

STEP 2: CONFIRMATION

After we receive your referral, a service coordinator will contact you to confirm your auto insurance claim details.

STEP 3: BOOKING APPOINTMENTS

Our registration office will call you to book your first rehab appointments.

You must set up your own reliable transportation before starting rehab. Speak with your auto insurance adjustor for insurance-funded transportation options, if needed.



STEP 4: YOUR FIRST DAY

Check in at Outpatient Registration, which is to the left when entering the main entrance.

Before going to therapy, you will meet with the service coordinator to review information about the billing process, creation of treatment plans and sharing information with your insurance company.


