3. OLD BUSINESS

3.1 Veterans Centre Occupancy ~ Update:

Overall occupancy at the Veterans Centre stands at 85% (85% Nursing Home Level, 86% Complex Continuing Care). There are 40 Preferred Admission Veterans awaiting placement.

3.2 Family Conferences ~ Follow up to November Meeting:

Attached is an existing sample document available in Point Click Care (the Veterans Centre electronic documentation system), entitled "INTERPROFESSIONAL Family Care Conference". N. Smokler brought the following proposal to FAC members:

Prior to the meeting, members of the care team input notes for discussion. Staff not present who have documented note, would have their comments read aloud. Following the conference, the document is updated to include expectations such as required follow-up (from one or multiple areas). Once completed, a copy of the document would be given provided the appropriate family member has signed a Release of Information form. Those in attendance were in agreement.

The final process to provide these will be organized and more information is forthcoming once this is finalized.

A full range of outpatient services in a senior-friendly space will be available, giving seniors and their families, much needed resources. The project is currently in the planning stages, with building/renovations to begin within 1-2 years.
