Feedback was provided on the new tables. Larger wheelchairs do not fit under the new tables, and some find they are too small. They are, however, stable. They will continue to be monitored.

5.1 Dr. Jocelyn Charles ~ Cipriano Centre Update & Outbreak Quality Improvement Project Update ~ Dr. J. Charles 1:30-1:45pm: Dr. Charles circulated the proposed plan for the entry of the Cipriano Centre.

Copies of the finalized design will be posted, once available.

As indicated by residents, extended days in outbreak negatively impacts overall quality of life. As a result of the Outbreak Quality Improvement Project, the following have been implemented:

- Formerly, lower (coronavirus) and higher (influenza) concerning viruses have been treated as equals, which will no longer occur.
- Barriers preventing staff calling in on the same day if ill, have been lifted, to reduce staff feeling they have to come in to work when sick.
- Protective equipment carts on all units were not following the standardized set-up, which is currently being changed.

Feedback on whether the improvement initiatives have reduced outbreaks and their duration will be made available later in the year.

5.2 Food Services Quarterly Update 2:00-2:15pm:

Once renovations are complete, Bill Goniotakis reported Sunny's will be carrying a combination of in-house baked goods, as well as outsourced products. Chairs in Sunny's are being replaced; samples of both types (with and without arms) are on display near the cash area.

Kelly Estwick reported hot dogs would no longer be part of the regular menu. Reportedly, the bottom crust on meat pies are not fully cooked; Food Services will look into the problem.

As requested by family at a previous FAC, two additional flavours of yoghurt have been added. Vanilla, peach, strawberry and blueberry are now available.
