3.1 OCTOBER REPORT

A copy of the October CEO Report was pre-circulated and appended to the agenda package for information.

Dr. McLellan commented that he would be pleased to answer questions on any matters arising from his written report.

The Chair thanked Dr. McLellan for his report and opened the floor for questions.

BOARD BUSINESS

4.0 EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION:

4.1 SUNNYBROOK SIMULATION CENTRE

Dr. Ari Zaretsky, Vice President Education introduced Dr. Jordan Tarshis, Director of Sunnybrook's Simulation Centre and Ms. Agnes Ryzynski, Manager of Sunnybrook's Simulation Centre. A copy of their presentation, 'Sunnybrook Canadian Simulation Centre", was pre-circulated and appended to the agenda package.

Dr. Tarshis, in presenting an overview of the Sunnybrook Canadian Simulation Centre, commented that the Centre celebrated a number of firsts, such as:

- ➤ 1st Simulation Centre in Canada (1995)
- > 1st Simulation Centre in Ontario to receive Accreditation from the Royal College (2012)
- > 1st Simulation Centre to receive a CIHR Research Grant.

Its trademark was registered in 2012 and it has attained academic partners throughout Canada as well as internationally. The high-tech simulations ready medical students for real-life situations. Dr. Tarshis commented that its strategic focus is to advance priority programs with new initiatives in:

- Women & Babies: for high risk obstetrics
- Advances of trauma care and cardiac surgery with multidisciplinary simulation sessions

The team is continuously striving to improve patient safety and continues to partner locally, nationally and internationally.

Ms. Ryzynski commented that the Centre has seen an increase of 67% in program growth since 2012, noting that in 2014 approximately 2,385 participants used the Sunnybrook Canadian Simulation Centre. The Simulation Centre is used for hands-on practice regarding catheter associated urinary tract infections (CAUTI) with an objective to decrease Sunnybrook's incidence by 60% by April 1st 2016. Ms. Ryzynski indicated that, to date, learners have shown a 40% increase in competence levels. The Simulation Centre was also used for intense training of members of the Ebola Strike Team.

Ms. Ryzynski commented that the Centre encourages patient engagement in training our future medical doctors. This concept has received extremely positive feedback from all. In closing, Ms. Ryzynski commented that the Centre's future directions are to:

• Increase the numbers of teachers and learners;

- Acquire new simulation equipment needed to expand access and opportunities for all learners;
- Expand quality improvement initiatives via skills acquisition, practice and impact measurement:
- Continue to expand national and international leadership.

Mr. Goldring thanked Dr. Tarshis and Ms. Ryzynski for their presentation and opened the floor for questions.
