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ARO Surveillance Program to Resume Thursday Jan. 27, 2022

Due to limited human resources, the hospital ARO Surveillance program had been put on hold once again in order to redirect efforts toward increased COVID testing demands brought on by the Omicron variant. As a result of provincial restrictions in testing, automation interventions and a steady decline in positivity rates we are able to initiate ARO surveillance screening once again.

The ARO Surveillance program will commence for all areas of the hospital beginning **Thursday January 27**th, including Admission screening swabs. Please resume regular ordering practices in EPR.
