TUBERCULIN SKIN TESTING (TB skin test). *All applicants must have a two-step TB skin test. TB skin tests cannot be performed within 4 weeks after receiving a live vaccination such as Varicella/MMR.		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> TB skin tests should be completed with your physician. A Tuberculosis (TB) skin test will tell you if you have been infected with the TB germs. It is <u>not</u> a vaccine. OHIP does not cover the cost of TB skin tests that are required for volunteer purposes. Please discuss the cost with your physician. Sunnybrook cannot cover the cost of charges by your physician. You may have the TB skin tests completed at Sunnybrook's Occupational Health & Safety department at no charge. 		
For Occupational Health & Safety department visits only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You do not need to make an appointment. No visits are available on statutory holidays or Fridays immediately prior to statutory holiday Mondays.

For those who have never had a two-step TB skin test this will involve 4 visits. It may take several weeks to complete. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit 1 - have your first test Visit 2 - have your first test read (48 to 72 hours after Visit 1) Visit 3 - have your second test (7 days to 12 months after Visit 1) Visit 4 - have your second test read (48 to 72 hours after Visit 3)
