The concert will benefit the construction of Sunnybrook's two new floors for births, high-risk pregnancies and critically-ill newborns.

The construction project, now in full swing at Sunnybrook's Bayview Avenue Campus, will be

ready to care for women and babies in 2010. Designed with input from women and their families, as well as their caregivers, the expansion will accommodate 4,250 annual births and house a leading-edge neonatal intensive care unit that will care for one in every five babies born in Ontario who weigh less than three pounds.

"We're delighted that such internationally-renowned talent are throwing their support behind Sunnybrook's Women & Babies Program," says Kevin Goldthorp, Chief Executive Officer, Sunnybrook Foundation. "This is the first time these incredible artists have all performed together; and it represents a truly unique fundraising event for the City of Toronto, which will be felt long after the night is over."
