Mandarin Charitable Foundation donates million dollar gift to Sunnybrook's Schulich Heart Centre

TORONTO, November 8, 2007 - Mandarin Charitable Foundation donates \$1 million gift to Sunnybrook Foundation in support of the Schulich Heart Centre at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre, celebrated today at an unveiling ceremony.

"The cardiac-vascular surgical team of the Schulich Heart Centre is very pleased to partner with the Mandarin Restaurant chain," says Dr. Robert Maggisano, senior vascular surgeon at Sunnybrook. "This investment will allow us to successfully treat patients that may not be treatable by currently available techniques, and will allow us to do so with less risk than we have ever experienced."

Mandarin's investment is targeted at improving the care of patients undergoing vascular procedures. The funding is equally designated to support the Endovascular Aneurysm Repair (EVAR) program, a minimally invasive technique used to treat high-risk patients, and renovations to the vascular unit. In recognition of this gift, the vascular clinic will be named the Mandarin Vascular Outpatient Clinic.

"It is exciting for the heart program to receive such support as it is a very important area. We are grateful that the Mandarin Charitable Foundation is doing its part to help create the future of health care," says Dr. Brian Gilbert, chief, Schulich Heart Centre, and head of cardiology at Sunnybrook. "This is a tremendous gift, our vascular physicians and scientists are thrilled."
